

What to Expect at Baby Quest



When You Drop Your Child Off:

- ❖ Please label your child and all his/her belongs (bag, cup/bottle, pacifier, blanket, etc.).
- ❖ The nursery worker will sign you in and give you and your child a corresponding bracelet. Please do not remove your bracelet until you have received your child back.
- ❖ If your child has allergies that could be relevant to their time in the nursery, please let the nursery worker know. You and your child will receive a special bracelet.
- ❖ If you are not on the registration list and will be attending regularly, please complete a registration form.

While Your Child is in Our Care:

- ❖ As we are able, a curriculum involving a few activities for the toddlers will be implemented.
- ❖ A graham cracker snack will be served to all toddlers, unless we are otherwise instructed.
- ❖ Please do not bring other food into the nursery (on baby or toddler side).
- ❖ Your child can have his/her own cup during snack time with water or juice. Please NO milk products.
- ❖ If you are needed during the service your/your child's bracelet number will be flashed on the boxes in the sanctuary, located at the front on the far left and right side of the stage.
- ❖ If you see SOS (505) flashed, that means that we need more people to help in the nursery because more children are being dropped off.

When You Pick Your Child Up:

- ❖ Please be prompt in picking up your child.
- ❖ The person with the bracelet on needs to pick up the child.
- ❖ Try not to peek into the nursery while waiting in line. It tends to upset the children and cause them to approach the door before it is their turn, which can be dangerous. We do not want any children to be inadvertently pushed or to be let out of the room.

When Serving in the Nursery:

- ❖ Arrive 15 minutes before the service begins so that parents can start dropping off their children.
- ❖ For safety purposes, we must have 1 adult for every 2 infants and 1 adult for every 3 toddlers. This is sometimes why we cannot accept more children in the nursery.
- ❖ Assist with the children, diapers, cleaning, etc.
- ❖ Plan to stay a few minutes after the service to clean up the rooms.
- ❖ If you cannot serve the dates that are on the schedule, call someone to switch and then call the nursery committee member of those services to let them know.
