Read Genesis 2 to help you determine the place that the clues below are referring to. Make sure to enter this place in the ultimate puzzle!



Egyptian	17.6 (44.7)
Common (short)	18 (45.7)
Babylonian (long)	19.8 (50.3)
Hebrew (long)	20.4 (51.8)
Egyptian (long)	20.6 (52.3)








