Week 7 Volume 2 DVD #2

I. Lesson Overview. Volume 2 DVD # 2 highlights some of our weapons in tearing down strongholds of lies we believe and their impact of sexual temptation. The full armor of God is spoken about. On our website at www.restonbible.org/allmen as you scroll down there is a link to spiritual warfare sermons by Mike Minter and Jim Supp that go into more detail on the very subjects that Dr. Roberts addresses.

II. Transparency/Accountability

At the heart of any addiction is a lie that someone told you and probably for a long time. Is there anything that you are still hiding. This might be something totally unrelated to sexual bondage.

III. Discussion

Watch volume 2 DVD #2. You can use your own questions but following are suggestions:

1. What is the word of your testimony? Why is your testimony important in overcoming sexual bondage or other addictions?
2. What lies have you believed and what are the corresponding truths in scripture that counter these specific lies. Example, sexual fantasies does not affect others in my life? Truth: 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 reveals that the battle for purity is in our thoughts and our thoughts drive our behavior. Therefore, our thoughts matter. How do lies affect the way we see God, ourselves, and others?

IV Week 7 Mission. – What was covered this week in the DVD makes it clear participating in mere religious activity and trying harder to clean up through some set of rules won't work. Galatians 2:20-21 is just one of a multitude of verses that apply. The LORD knows everything we have ever done, ever thought or will ever do or think. Christ loves us and accepts us right here and now. So begin where you are.

Continue memorizing 1 Corinthians 6:13-20. Begin to memorize the foundational truths of Romans 6. Journal your struggles. Insure that the temptations of technology continue to be properly addressed. "Make no provision..." Prepare before you go to bed each night. Understand what situations and circumstances arouse you, what Roberts calls your "arousal template". The Holy Spirit will then warn you and prompt you to avoid or flee from them. Identifying possible buried wounds, trauma and the lies attached to them.
