what is freshmen fellowship?

In the Sr. High Student Ministry we want to be disciples who make disciples; Freshmen Fellowship is one way for students to be a part of this. Freshmen Fellowship is a faith-driven mentorship program where upperclassmen mentor the rising freshmen. This is done through monthly Freshmen Fellowship Meetings as well as 1:1 hangouts. This program is one semester long: September-December.

The mentors who are chosen for Freshmen Fellowship will be mentored by the RBC Sr. High staff outside of Freshmen Fellowship, learning first-hand what it means to discover God through ministry and engage His people.



why be a part?

- Freshmen Fellowship exhorts you to pour into the rising freshmen by the study of God's Word in a way that is both formal through the Freshmen Fellowship meetings and informal through 1:1 hangouts. You already have enough Biblical knowledge; now it's time to live it out in faithful obedience to Jesus' command in Matthew 28.
 - This is a unique opportunity for you to be mentored by a staff member, equipped to use your spiritual gifts, and receive an educational and experiential glimpse into ministry.
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what do the meetings look like?

- Freshmen Fellowship meetings will take place one Sunday each month (September-December) from 6:30-9:30pm in the Senior High Room, led by Sydney Morello and Jack Evans. The mentors will teach through the provided Biblical curriculum, conduct games, lead prayer, and organize ways to promote application of the teaching.
 - Mentor-only meetings will happen with Sr. High staff in a classroom setting twice a month: Wednesdays before small groups 5:00-6:30pm at RBC.
 - Outside of these meetings, mentors will organize individual hangouts with their freshmen to continue the relationship building in less of a formal setting: this is the time to have fun, but also talk about life and spiritual matters.
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what is the commitment?

- Weekly during your first semester of school (September 13-December 17) between 1:1 hangouts, mentor meetings, and Freshmen Fellowship Meetings .
- Showing up on-time and being an active part of each meeting and hangout time.
- Working through the assigned workbook pages beforehand (two chapters each month).
- Attending the first mentor meeting on Wednesday, September 13 5-6:30pm.
- Working with your rising freshman to hangout outside of the regular Freshmen Fellowship meetings.
- Being prepared for what you may be leading in the Freshmen Fellowship meeting.
- To be seeking a daily relationship with the Lord and desiring to walk in faithful obedience.
