Biblical Basis for World Missions Gen 1:26-28 Creation of man, Day 6

26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

27 So God created man in *his own image, in the image of God* he created him;

male and female he created them.

28 And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Biblical Basis for World Missions Gen 12:1-3 Abrahamic Covenant

1 Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you.

2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.

3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Biblical Basis for World Missions Galatians 3:8

And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed."

Biblical Basis for World Missions Mt 28:18-20 The Great Commission

18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Nations = Ethne = Ethnic people groups






Countries vs Nations

Nigeria - 544 nations






How many ethnic people groups are there?

Current Estimate: 17,000







How many people groups are considered unreached?

Less than 2% Evangelical and less than 5% Christian Adherent

Current estimate: 7,000 (41%)










Where are these unreached peoples?



5 out of 6 unreached people groups are in the 10/40 Window

Countries with the most unreached people groups

Country	Unreached People Groups
India	2291
China	446
Pakistan	408
Bangladesh	291
Nepal	266




"Islam is growing faster than Christianity." Agree or disagree?






Major Religions Annual Growth Rates

The Great Shift

Year	% Christians in Europe, North America	% Christians in Latin America, Africa, Asia
1800	99%	1%
1900	90%	10%
1979	50%	50%
2018	23%	77%
2050	15%	85%

There are now as many Christfollowers in China as in North America.







The Great Shift

The new faces of the Body of Christ From countries like Nigeria, Brazil, India and China












Rise of Asian, Africa and Trends Latin American missionaries



Movements of Muslims to Christ

600-1800 No known movements

1800-1980 2 movements (Indonesia and Ethiopia)

1980-2000 11 movements (Iran, Algeria, Bulgaria, Albania, West Africa, Bangladesh, Central Asia)

2000-2013 69 movements (across the globe)

Definition of a movement

- At least 1,000 baptized believers
 OR 100 new church starts
 - Over a two-decade period
