POSITIONAL CONTEXT: Jesus is "at the right hand of God" which indicates:

- His Ultimate Power & Authority (Ephesians 1:19-21)
 - His Messianic Fulfillment (Psalm 110, Matthew 22:44)
 - His Ongoing Love & Favor (Romans 8:31-

Our response to who/where Jesus is:

- "SET" Active pursuit; not passive
- "YOUR MINDS" The mind serves as the watchman of the soul
- "ABOVE" Our primary focus must shift from earthly things to the massive foundational reality of Jesus Christ
- Individual & Corporate: Y'ALL set Y'ALL'S minds

Colossians 3:3

- "You have died..."
- Dead to the world, alive in Jesus (Col. 2:20)

- "...your life is hidden in Christ..."
- Protected, secure
- Paul's summary: Galatians 2:20

Colossians 3:4

Christ appears & you appear with Him!

FUTURE HOPE

- The invisible hope of glory believed on by faith will become visible to all.
- Looking ahead at what is to come helps us be good stewards of where we are now.

Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. On account of these the wrath of God is coming.

In these you too once walked, when you were living in them. But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.

V. 5: "Be killing sin, or sin will be killing you." (John Owen, *The Mortification of Sin*)

V. 6: A sober warning! God's wrath, now hidden, will also be revealed.

V. 7: We have no moral high ground to condemn each other.

V. 8: Renounce, throw down, cast off the weight of your old identity (Hebrews 12:1), but not by worldly, human standards (Colossians 2:20-23).

V. 9: You can't lie to someone without telling lies about God.

...And have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.

Colossians 3:10

- "...put on the new self..."
 - Live from your new identity (2 Cor. 5:17)
- "...which is being renewed..."
 - Active, ongoing process
- "...in knowledge..."
 - Uphold the standard of the Word
- "...after the image of its creator."
- Your core purpose/identity Imago Dei

Put on that which best reflects the hidden reality of your new identity in **Jesus.** (Romans 13:14, Galatians 3:26-28)

GOD'S CHOSEN ONES:

Holy – pure, right, set apart

Beloved – adopted, rescued, dear

Two categories of interaction and two ways of "putting on":

STRANGENESS (FORBEAR): Don't treat the strangeness of others as if it were sin.

SIN (FORGIVE): Don't expect better treatment than Jesus got. Forgive as you have been forgiven.

And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. Colossians 3:14

So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love. — 1 Corinthians 13:13
