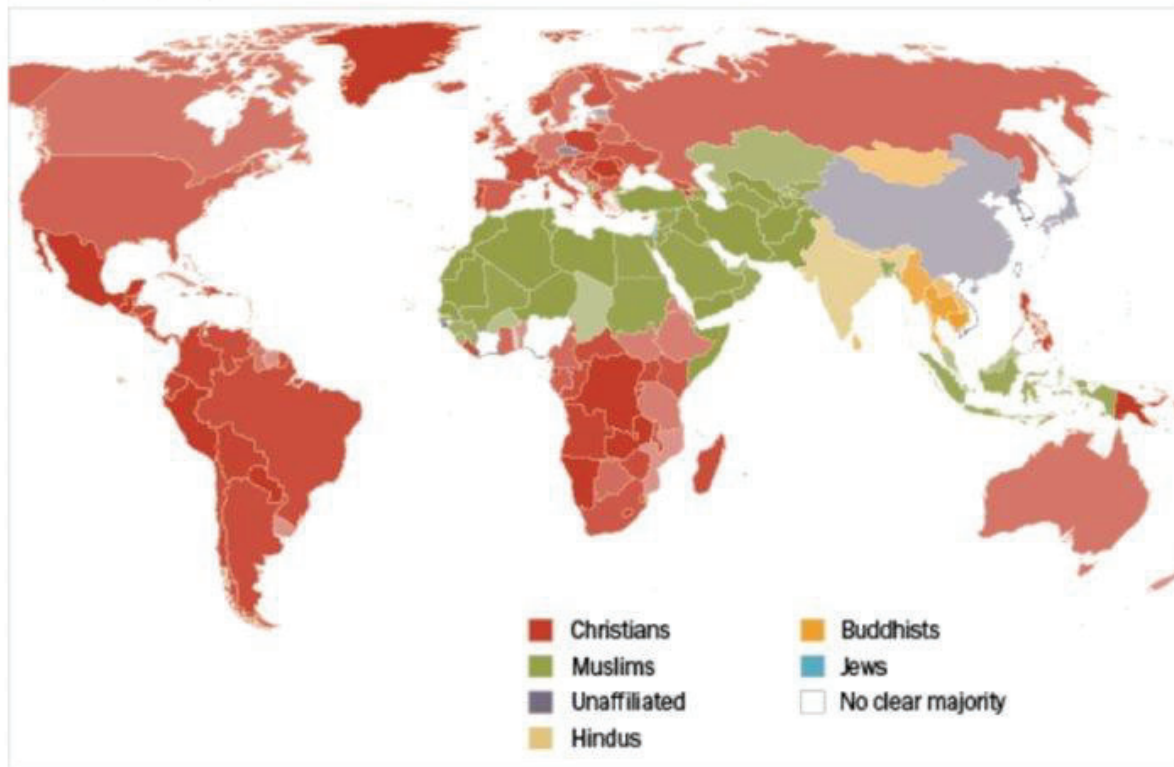

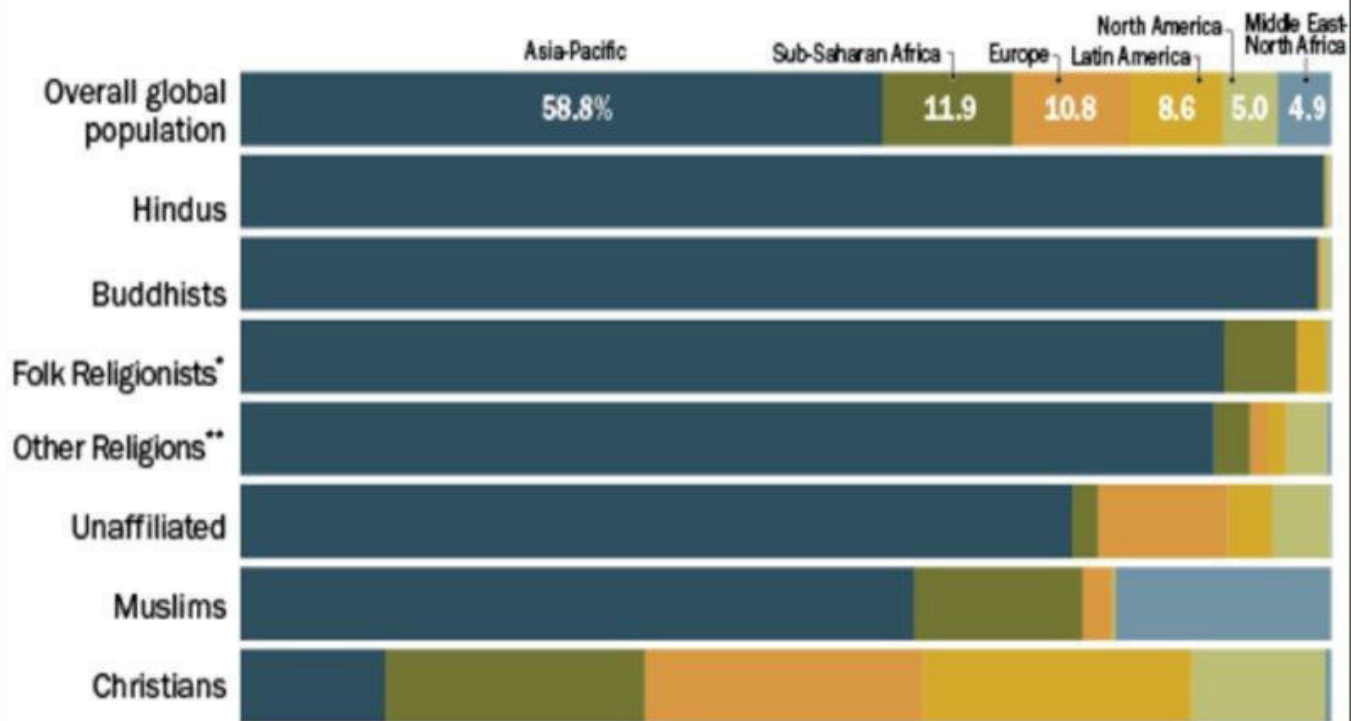
Majority Religion, by Country

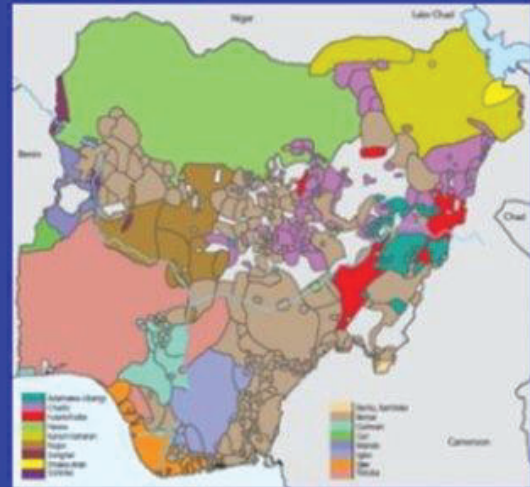

- **3%** of missionaries working among unreached people

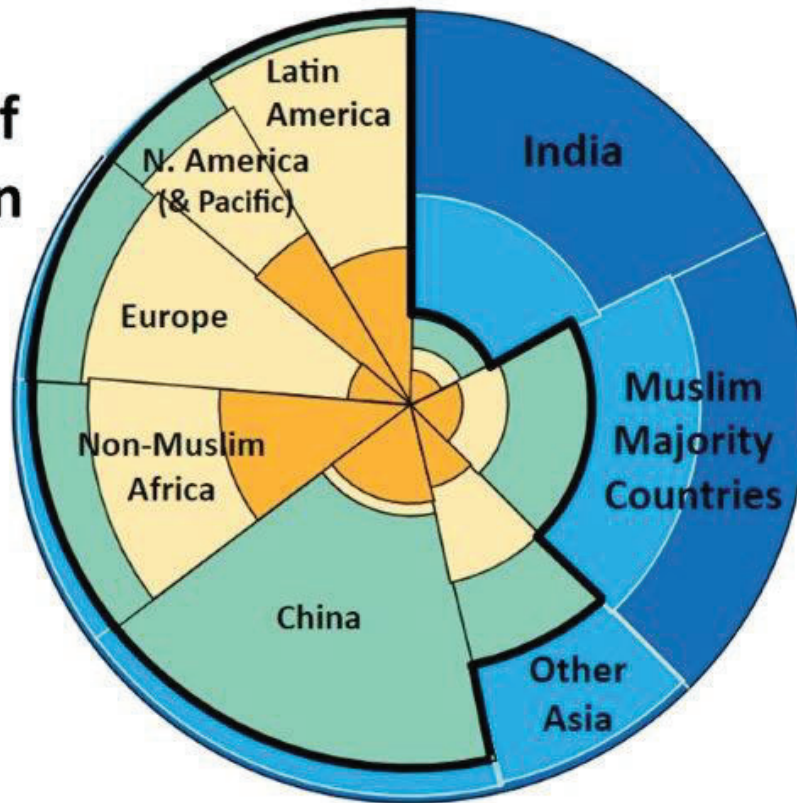




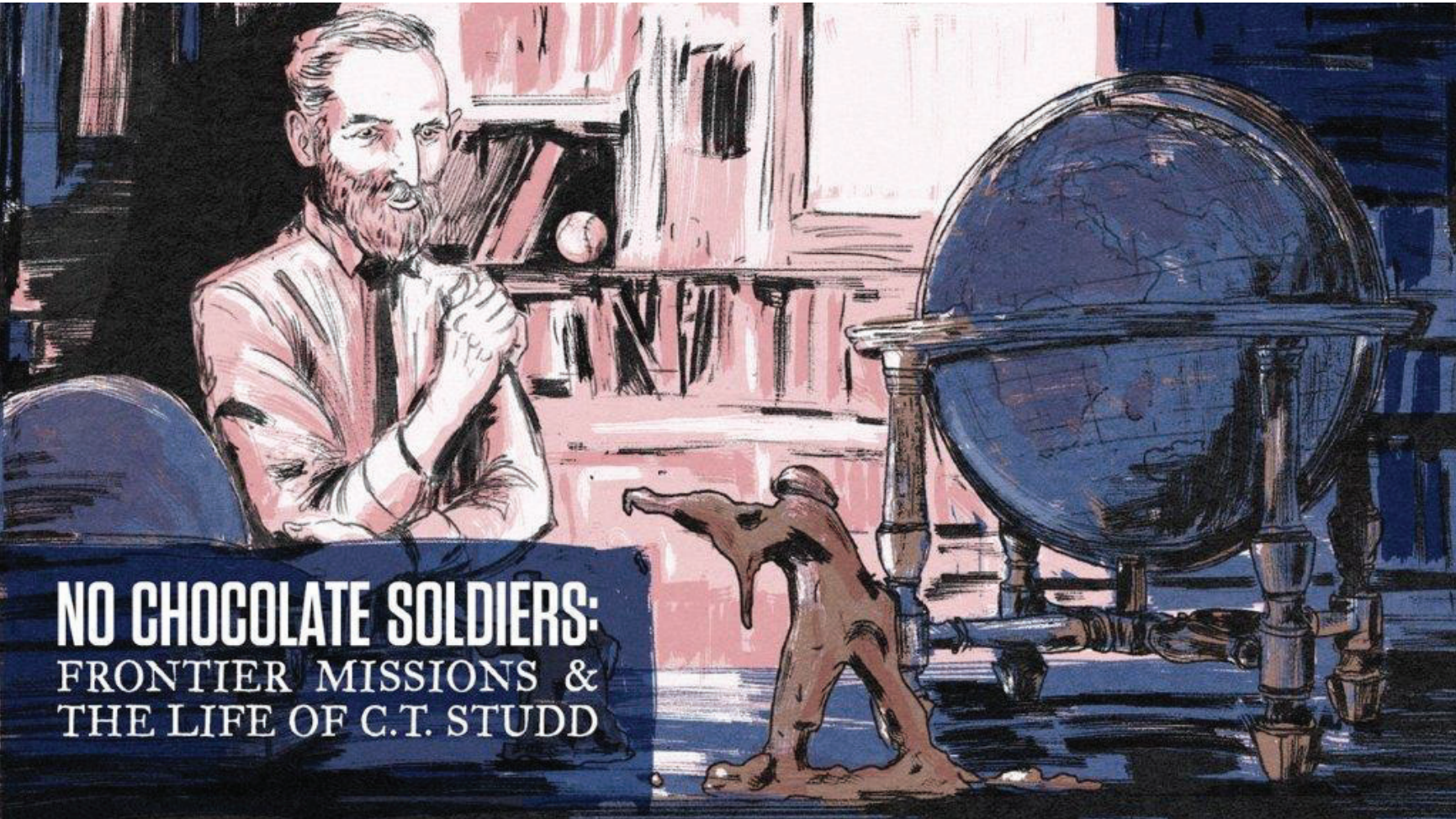
FRONTIER MISSIONS-THE **BAD** NEWS

- **0.5%** of Christian giving goes to unreached people

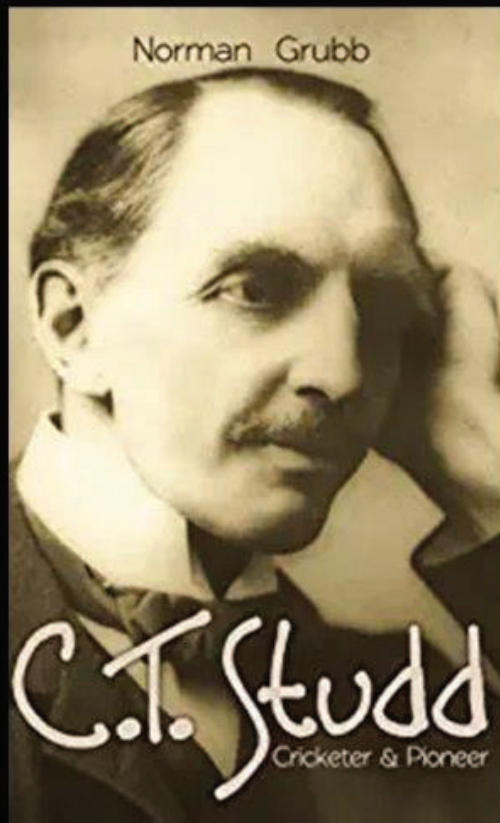

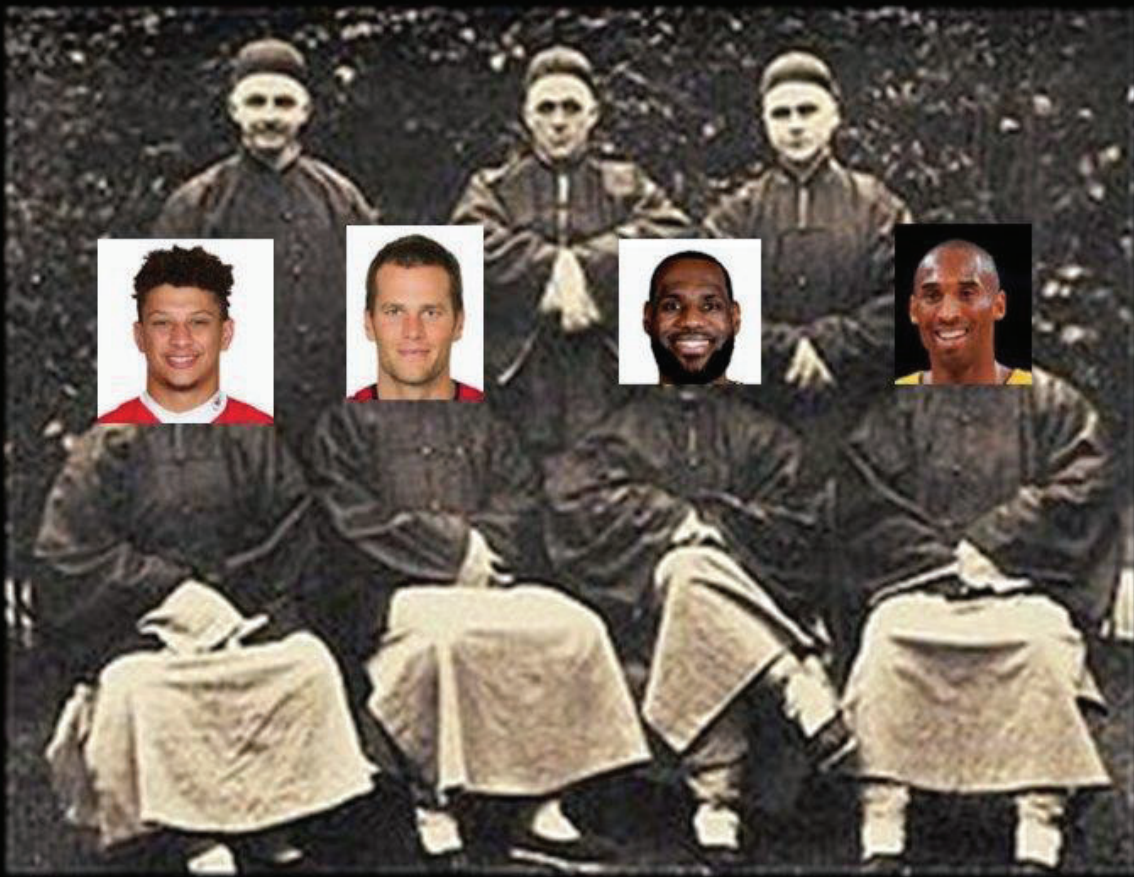
