The Addition Method

1 person leads 1000 people each year to Christ but doesn't disciple them 1 x 1000 x 33 years = 33,000

The Multiplication Method

1 person leads another person to Christ each year and disciples them to the point they then do the same

The 1st year = 2 people
The 2nd year = 4 people
The 3rd year = 8 people

The Multiplication Method

The 19th year = 500,000 people

The 33rd year = 8.6 billion people


