Week 2 – God Uses The Broken But Humble 1 Timothy



The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

1 Timothy 1:5 ESV

I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service, though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent. But I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief, and the grace of our Lord overflowed for me with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus.


### 1. Appointed to God's Service

I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service...

1 Timothy 1:12 ESV

Faithful – worthy of responsibility or trust.

Appointing – assigning of responsibility.

### 2. Foremost of Sinners

Blasphemer: evil-speaking, irreverent toward the sacred

Persecutor: systematic hunting down of an adherent to a particular religion to inflict pain or death.

Insolent Opponent: characterized by offensive & disrespectful acts or statements that are outrageously bold.

The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.





Meeting with Bishops in the Tower of London before his execution





### 3. Acted in Ignorance


But I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display his perfect patience as an example to those who were to believe in him for eternal life.

**Grace** – good favor of God that is undeserved

Mercy – to have pity on; leniency, not getting what is deserved

Patience – forbearance, patient endurance



"This is the second offense and justice requires death."
