Volunteer Opportunities

Sunday Morning Table Leader

The Senior High Worship Service is every Sunday from 10:45 a.m. to 12:05 p.m. in the Youth Building (the separate building on the Reston Bible Church campus).

When you enter the Youth Building, go to the right side as you walk in, that's the Sr. High side. Feel free to join us at 10:30 a.m. for donuts and hanging out before we kick off.

Senior High Sunday mornings are the main time for our whole group to gather together for:

- **Worship:** Praising, thanking, and giving Jesus the honor and glory He is due through song.
- **Teaching:** God's Word is the source of truth and life change we all need. We focus on teaching God's Word in a way that stays true to the text and is relevant to students' lives.
- **Table Sharing:** Students sit at tables with leaders and other students to discuss questions related to the morning's message and other things like prayer, games, and discussion.
- **Different Elements:** Each week, we have a different element like a game, prayer, a video, testimonies, stories of God working and more. These elements help students engage with each other and God in different ways.

Wednesday Night Small Group Leader

A small group is typically 6-8 same-gender students and led by a same-gender, trained adult leader who is committed to building relationships with the students in their group and studying God's Word for understanding and application. We believe God's Word is the true change agent.

Small Groups gather every Wednesday from September through May. Typically, on the first Wednesday of the month, all small groups meet on the Reston Bible Church campus. Small Groups meet in regional homes on the other Wednesdays.

A typical Wednesday night will consist of hanging out to catch up, eating snacks, announcements, a student-led activity (ex. worship, game, testimony), and then splitting up into small groups for prayer, updates, and then opening God's Word and discussing the previous Senior High Sunday message.

Camp and Retreat Leaders

Summer camp is always the last full week of July (Sunday-Saturday) and Winter Retreat is always president's day weekend (Friday-Monday) every year. At these camps and retreats, the main volunteer opportunity is being a small group leader. A small group leader at a camp or retreat will lead students through pre-written discussion questions based on the messages that will be given every morning and evening. The goal is to help students understand and discuss the things that were presented to them during the Morning and Evening meetings.

Monthly Events

Our monthly events will typically be held on a Sunday evening with a few exceptions. This is a time where students get together and invite their friends to do something fun and at the end of the night, the gospel will be delivered. These are largely considered to be outreach events meant to reach students outside of our ministry.
