Steadfast Love - Chesed - encompasses love, mercy, kindness, compassion, faithfulness, patience.

Goodness (Steadfast Love) - God's innate goodwill toward sinners. By nature tenderhearted, compassionate, benevolent.

NASB - Lovingkindness NIV - Unfailing love

1. God is Good to His Creation

2. God is Good to His Disobedient People
