Walk ancient roads where the Apostle Paul traveled.

Read Scripture where it was first written.

Encounter the living Word as history, geography, and faith converge.

Together, we will open Scripture on location, reflect in community, and invite God to deepen our faith through lived experience.





JOURNEY HIGHLIGHTS

Philippi

- Stand where Paul first preached on European soil (Acts 16).
- **Archaeological Site of Philippi** — Explore the Roman Forum, prison site, and theater where Paul and Silas were beaten and imprisoned.
- **Saint Lydia's Baptistry** — Visit the riverside where Lydia was baptized.

Neapolis (Kavala)

- Visit the same harbor Paul used on his second missionary journey. Walk along preserved sections of the Via Egnatia, the Roman road that carried the Gospel westward.

Thessaloniki

- **Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki** — Discover artifacts that illuminate the book of Acts and Paul's letters.
- **Roman Forum of Thessaloniki** — See where Jason was tried while Paul fled to Berea (Acts 17), confirming Luke's precise historical detail.
- **Church of Agios Dimitrios** — A powerful testimony of martyrdom, perseverance, and worship through the centuries.

Berea (Veria) & Vergina

- **Ancient Berea** — Visit the city praised for examining the Scriptures daily (Acts 17).
- **Royal Macedonian Tombs of Vergina** — Enter the tomb of Philip II and reflect on human power, mortality, and biblical hope.
- **Royal Palace and Theater of Aigai** — Walk the site where history turned and Alexander the Great's rise reshaped the world into which Christ would later come.

Meteora

- Ascend to the dramatic cliff-top monasteries, once reachable only by ropes and ladders. Reflect on prayer, solitude, worship, and faithfulness through centuries of devotion.

Delphi

- Archaeological Museum of Delphi** — View the Gallio Inscription, anchoring the Book of Acts in history.

Corinth

- Archaeological Site of Ancient Corinth** — Stand where Paul ministered for 18 months, worked as a tentmaker, and faced trial before Gallio (Acts 18).
- Acrocorinth** — Overlook the city from the fortress above, reflecting on holiness amid cultural compromise.

Athens

- Mars Hill (Areopagus)** — Stand where Paul proclaimed Christ to philosophers (Acts 17), overlooking the Agora.
- Acropolis and Parthenon** — Marvel at these ancient architectures.

- Ephesus** — Reflect on Paul's epistle to the Ephesians as we walk one of the world's best-preserved ancient cities where Paul ministered for three years.
- Patmos** — Enter the Grotto of the Apocalypse where John received the book of Revelation.
- Crete** — Explore biblical and cultural heritage linked to Titus.
- Santorini** — Experience breathtaking cliffs, iconic sunsets, and vibrant beauty.
- Mykonos** — Enjoy exploration in this vibrant island port.
